

WILDFIRE DISPOSAL GUIDELINES DEBRIS, CONTAMINATED SOIL & ASH DISPOSAL COFFIN BUTTE LANDFILL

Updated: October 14, 2020

Cleaning up after a wildfire can be a challenging and dangerous activity that has immediate and long-term physical health risks and impacts to the environment. Wildfire debris can contain many types of hazardous materials. As a result, there are special requirements for transporting and disposing of wildfire debris.

Coffin Butte Landfill Acceptance Policy

Debris, Ash and Soil from ALL Properties require a Special Waste Profile Form signed by the generator of the material to be disposed of. Profile forms can be found here: <https://www.republicservices.com/businesses/special-waste>.

CLEANUP OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES

- **Debris/Ash/Soil:** Must be accompanied by an appropriate asbestos survey, taken by a certified asbestos consultant/expert, that certifies it does not contain asbestos. Residences/Structures built after 2004 do not require asbestos survey.
- **Debris/Ash/Soil that contain asbestos >1%:** Must be remediated by a certified asbestos consultant/expert and packaged for disposal in accordance with applicable laws and guidelines for disposal at Coffin Butte Landfill. For more information go to <https://coffinbuttelandfill.com>.

CLEANUP OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES

- **Building/Structure Debris (non-ash):** Must be accompanied by an appropriate asbestos survey that certifies it does not contain asbestos.**
- **Debris/Ash/Soil:** Must be accompanied by the appropriate asbestos survey from a certified asbestos inspector. The following analytical will need to be submitted with the waste profile form, TCLP metals* and asbestos**. Ash delivered to the Coffin Butte Landfill by commercial haulers must be wetted down prior to transportation.
- **Debris/Ash/Soil that contain asbestos >1%:** Must be remediated by a certified asbestos consultant/expert and packaged for disposal in accordance with applicable laws and guidelines for disposal at Coffin Butte Landfill. TCLP

metals analyses will also be required. For more information go to <https://coffinbuttelandfill.com>.

Customers with **pre-established accounts** (including prepayment or credit approval) may deliver waste to the Coffin Butte Landfill. All other accounts will be set-up upon waste acceptance approval. This Waste Acceptance Policy for the management of waste generated as a result of the wildfires is subject to change and is provided for general information only and does not supersede any legal requirements that apply to the Coffin Butte Landfill.
