\$64,330

Designated funding received through Workplace Campaigns, or direct contributions. United Way commits to giving every dollar of designated funds without service or administrative fees.

\$9,000

Direct funding to support urgent, unmet needs by families or individuals at risk or in need of temporary financial assistance through the Yamhill County Service Integration Team.

\$31,600
